Ponderings

Here are a few “August” saints:

August 8th Feast of St. Dominic

St. Dominic was born in Spain around the year 1170. His parents were members of the nobility. He was ordained a priest and was asked by Bishop Diego of Osma to participate in local church reforms. He spent nine years there. While traveling with the bishop in France he noticed the bad effects of the Albigensian heresy which had become popular. Dominic began to think about founding a religious order to promote the truth. He later received permission of the bishop to found an order whose mission would be preaching. He obtained papal approval in 1216. They would be called the Order of Preachers.

August 10th Feast of St. Lawrence

Lawrence was chief among seven deacons who served the Church in Rome in the mid-third century. He was much venerated by the ancient Roman Church. One of his responsibilities was to care for the temporal goods of the Church and to distribute assistance to the poor. During the persecution of the Roman Emperor Valerian, he was ordered to surrender the treasures of the Church. Lawrence brought together the poor and the sick. He said, “Here are the treasures of the Church!” Lawrence was tortured, scourged and eventually met his death by being placed on a hot gridiron.

August 20th Feast of St. Bernard

Bernard is regarded as the last of the Church Fathers. He was born in 1090 and died in 1152. He was born into an aristocratic family but slowly made his way to monastic life. At 20 he entered the Cistercian order—a community of religious men founded in 1098 and dedicated to the strict observance of St. Benedict’s ancient rule. His abbot sent him after five years to found a new monastery in Clairvaux, France. His reputation as a wise and learned leader resulted in many people, including many bishops, seeking his counsel. When a Cistercian was elected pope and sought Bernard’s wise advice, he began his work of reforming the papacy. He had a great devotion to the Blessed Mother, and many prayers, including the Memorare were attributed to him. He was named a Doctor of the church in 1830---called the ‘doctor of honey’ for the sweet eloquence of his words. He died at Clairvaux in 1153 and was canonized just over 20 years later.

August 28th Feast of St. Augustine

St. Augustine converted to Christianity in 386 and was an influential theologian and writer in Numidia (modern day Algeria). This was a Roman colony at that time. In 384 he was given a position as a professor of rhetoric at the Imperial Court of Milan. He became friendly with the bishop of Milan, Bishop Ambrose. Under the influence of Bishop Ambrose, Augustine, at the age of 31, made a formal conversion to Christianity. He wrote an account of his conversion in his book ‘Confessions’. In 391 he became the Bishop of Hippo (north Africa) and for the next 39 years became an influential preacher. In the second half of his life, he was noted for his piety and simplicity of life. He continued to write, including ‘The City of God’.

Our liturgical calendar contains many ‘feast days’ for the saints of our Church---these are just a few of them for the month of August. Their heroic and virtuous lives have and continue to be an inspiration for all of us who want to live our lives of faith in an authentic way.

Maintenance Issues Update:

Issue #1: Leaks in the roof that covers the corridor between the church and the parish center. If you look at the ceiling just outside the restrooms and at the end of that corridor you will see some 'discoloration'----from the rain. We are having a contractor look at this problem.

Issue #2: Rectory basement had quite a bit of water during the spring rainstorms. There is one sump pump in the basement. It has been recommended that we put two more sump pumps in the basement. We are contacting companies for bids at the present time.

Heralds of Good News

Heralds of Good News is a Missionary Society of Apostolic Life, Founded in Eluru diocese, India on 14 October 1984; it became an Institute of Pontifical Right on May 5, 1999. The specific aim of the Society is the promotion of vocations to priesthood, the training of seminarians and the supply of zealous and hardworking missionaries to the dioceses in India and abroad which experience a shortage of priests due to the lack of local vocations. Currently, the Order is blessed with 478 priests and 150 seminarians studying at various levels of formation, and Mother Theresa Province (one of the 5 Provinces) is blessed with 71 priests 55 Seminarians.

I am glad to bring to you information that priests from this order are serving in this diocese since the year 2021 and one more priest is coming in to the diocese shortly. Our priests are already serving in 10 Mission dioceses in India and 4 countries (Australia, Canada, Italy, and United States of America). The Mission motto of our Province is "To live our call as Heralds with apostolic availability, adaptability, and openness, relying on divine providence and the intercession of our Heavenly Patrons and in imitation of St. Theresa of Kolkata's Love for the poor and the needy. Fr. Albert Francis HGN will be here to preach about the missionary work of Heralds of Good News during the weekend of **August 17 & 18**. Please support generously in the second collection during that weekend and take active part in the work of Evangelization in the Third Millennium.
